

## Summary of the PCC meeting held on 22 March 2018

At the PCC meeting held on 22 March, the business included:

### Parish Ordinand

The PCC was delighted to learn that our Parish Ordinand and Administrator, Dan Warnke, has been appointed to a Title post and will take up his new role following his ordination this summer. The PCC offered him our warmest congratulations.

### Tower Project

The Church has recently sought expert advice from structural and scaffolding engineers, and the work on the Tower will be carried out by means of a scaffolding “coronet” round the Tower, with scaffolding down the west side. It is hoped that the work will start this Autumn, and could be completed within six months.

The PCC recorded its warm appreciation of a very generous offer from our sister Church, Trinity Church Wall Street, New York, to contribute £100k. towards the costs of the Tower Project.

### Equal Opportunities Policies

The PCC agreed that the two current Church Equal Opportunities Projects (for Church Staff and for the Public) should remain the same.

### Annual Report

The PCC approved the draft Annual Report for 2017. This will be presented at the APCM on 19 April together with the Annual Accounts.

### Revision of the Electoral Roll

Following a review of the Electoral Roll by the Rector and Parish Secretary, the PCC approved the proposed revisions. There are currently 83 people on the Church’s Electoral Roll.

### Church Environmental Champion

Our Church is the only Church in the City to have been awarded an Ecochurch Bronze Award. The PCC agreed to appoint Alan Hovell as our Environmental Champion. Alan takes over from Dan Hedley, Church Warden, who is the current Environmental Lead.

### LIVE in the Churchyard – 25 – 28 June 2018

This exciting event will again be taking place towards the end of June. Further details to be announced shortly.

### Visitation by the Archdeacon

The PCC received copies of a report on a recent visitation by the Archdeacon. Generally, the Archdeacon had given the Church a clean bill of health with only minor recommendations for change and the Church and PCC are already taking these forward.

### MAP 2018 – 2023

The PCC approved the latest MAP proposal and recorded its warm appreciation of all the work carried out by Dan Warnke on the project. Dan will be giving a presentation on the MAP at the APCM.
