

Summary of PCC meeting held on 22 November 2018

Videographer for Weddings

The Church is seeking to identify a suitable videographer who can be on hand when a request is made for a video recording of a wedding Service.

Tower Project

The PCC received a report on the Project. PCC members were pleased to see that scaffolding is now being erected round the Tower. Despite the delay in starting work caused by the recent stonefall and resulting remedial action, the contractors are still planning to complete their work by the end of March 2019. It was noted that, as with all such building projects, however, once the project is underway it may be found that more extensive work is required.
