

Summary of PCC meeting held on 17 January 2019

At its last meeting the main items for consideration by the PCC included:

Church Policies

The PCC approved a policy for the use of Social Media by church members. A Complaints Policy was also approved.

Church building works

A progress report on works to the Church Tower was received.

Some of the stonework in the Church Crypt dates back as far as the eleventh century and the mortar is showing signs of decay. The PCC approved a proposal from the Church's Architect on repairs to the mortar, initially to be carried out on an experimental basis on three separate areas (the worst affected.)

Sustainability

Protecting the Environment and how the Church can promote sustainability forms part of the Church's Mission Action Plan.

The Church's Environmental Champion, Alan Hovell, who is a PCC member, has generously donated copies of a booklet entitled "No More Plastic" to all PCC members and members of the Church Staff. PCC members were invited to read the booklet and bring concrete suggestions to a future PCC meeting.

It was felt that the most effective way the Church can promote environmental change is through working with local businesses, for instance through the Cheapside Business Alliance.
