

Summary of PCC meeting held on 21 November 2019

Major items discussed at the PCC on 21 November included:

Tower works

The works on the Tower have now been completed and bell-ringing restored.

Fundraising

Restoration works to the Tower have been very costly and drawn heavily on Church reserves. The Rector acknowledged with warm thanks contributions received to date from members of the Congregation. The PCC recognised the urgent need for further fundraising to restore the reserves to their previous level. A fundraising strategy is being developed.

West Steps

The PCC approved a proposal to restore the damage to the West Steps early in the New Year.

Sustainability

The Rector informed the PCC that he and the Church's Environmental Champion, Alan Hovell, had had a helpful meeting with the newly appointed City employee responsible for sustainability. It is hoped to develop stronger links between him and the Church.

Environmental Policy

Linked to sustainability is the Church's Environmental Policy. Much work has been done in the Church recently to improve our green credentials. The current environmental policy is out of date so it was agreed that the Rector review the policy and bring a revised version to the next PCC meeting.

Resilience Policy

Similarly it was noted that the Church's Resilience Policy (our Emergency Incident Drill) required some minor revision.
